Josefsberg Honored With The Florida Bar President's Pro Bono Service Award


Robert C. Josefsberg is a senior partner at Podhurst, Orseck, P.A. in Miami. The AV-rated trial attorney's principal areas of practice are commercial litigation, criminal litigation and white-collar crime. He became a Florida Bar member in 1962.

Josefsberg has contributed a large number of pro bono hours through such programs as Put Something Back, Legal Aid Society, Dade County Bar and 11th Judicial Circuit, Legal Services of Greater Miami, Inc., Federal Bar and B'nai Brith Bar. He devotes more than 300 pro bono hours annually to improving the legal profession through his several professional affiliations. Additionally, he donates hundreds of pro bono hours to individuals and organizations in cases of adoption, divorce, custody, visitation, guardian ad litem, not-for-profit, and consumer cases.

He is a past president and dean of the International Academy of Trial Lawyers, president of the Peter T. Fay American Inns of Court, and chairman of The American Bar Association Standing Committee on the Judiciary. He also served as general counsel to Gov. Bob Graham in 1980. Along with his membership in a myriad of other professional and civic organizations and programs, he is extensively involved in the lecturing circuit.

Josefsberg received his Juris Doctor degree from the Yale Law School and earned his Bachelor of Arts degree from Dartmouth College. He is a native of Brooklyn, N.Y.

The Florida Bar President's Pro Bono Service Award was established in 1981. Its purpose is twofold: "to further encourage lawyers to volunteer free legal services to the poor by recognizing those who make such public service commitments, and to communicate to the public some sense of the substantial volunteer services provided by Florida lawyers to those who cannot afford legal fees." This award recognizes individual lawyer service in each of Florida's specific judicial circuits.
